### Register Now for Spring Campus Day – All Students Must Register!

Registration for Spring Campus Day is now open! All students, even those in year-long continuing classes, **must register**. Class Schedule and Class Descriptions are attached to this e-mail. **Semester classes (those without an asterisk) are open to new students. \*Year-long classes are not open to new students. Each Campus Day student is required to have a parent volunteer during Campus Day at least 16 hours per semester unless applying for Drop Off, which incurs an extra fee.** See page 7 of our [Policy Manual](#) for Campus Day fees.

A Registration Form for each student is due **December 10<sup>th</sup>**; however, **we encourage everyone to register now as some classes will fill up!** See registration form for registration priority details (teachers, helpers, auxiliary, then drop off). Priority ends December 10<sup>th</sup>. You will receive a confirmation e-mail of your class requests. If we cannot fulfill your class request, you will receive an e-mail by December 15<sup>th</sup>. ### Start Collecting - Yearbook Pictures Due January 10th!

Each family who purchased or earned a yearbook through ads receives a family page and those with seniors receive a senior page (If a family has only one student who is a senior, they will receive a senior page and not a family page.). **Families will need to submit pictures for their page(s) by January 10th.** See below for more details.

Family Page: Please be prepared to turn in 7-9 recent (this last summer/school year) photos. Keep in mind one of those will need to be a family picture, so if you don't have a recent one, Christmas is a great time to have someone take one for you. This does not need to be a professionally taken photo.

Senior Page: Please be prepared to turn in 8-10 photos. At least one of those will need to be a senior photo and a baby picture. You can fill in the rest with photos of them growing up through the years. If your senior hasn't taken senior photos yet, you can hold off on turning that in, but we will need the rest of the through the years pictures in January, so get out the tissue and those shoeboxes of old pictures and start digging.
