Senior Page: Please be prepared to turn in 8-10 photos. At least one of those will need to be a senior photo and a baby picture. You can fill in the rest with photos of them growing up through the years. If your senior hasn't taken senior photos yet, you can hold off on turning that in, but we will need the rest of the through the years pictures in January, so get out the tissue and those shoeboxes of old pictures and start digging.

On April 17-18, 2018, we will have the opportunity to experience the day in the life of a soldier stationed at Camp Reynolds in 1864. In this program student will learn how to complete musket drills, handle a caplock musket, cook dinner for our group, bake bread and cinnamon rolls, use Morse code with flags, and hike using a compass. A cannon firing will be done by the park staff on the day we depart. It is a wonderful experience at a historical site with beautiful views both day and night. For grades 3-6th. Cost will be \$75 per person; \$37.50 will be billed on your February 1st statement and \$37.50 on your March 1st statement. We need 9 adults to attend.
